After reading the Proclamation of Accession, the Mayor will lead with

“God Save the King.”

Official guests are to respond, “**God Save the King.**”

All present then join in saying “**God Save the King.**”

The Wantage Silver Band will play one verse of the National Anthem.

(Those in uniform are to salute)

God save our gracious King!

Long live our noble King!

God save the King!

Send him victorious,

Happy and glorious,

Long to reign over us,

God save the King.

The Mayor will ask all (including those in uniform) to remove their headdress and hold it above their right shoulder.

The Mayor will give “Three Cheers for His Majesty the King”.
